National Sports Day Events Kick Off in September — Two Special Offers Invite Everyone to Get Moving!

To strengthen and continuously promote the nationwide sports for all movement, the Department of Sports for All under the Ministry of Sports officially launched the “National Sports Day” series of activities in September.

This year the Department invited 2024 Paris Olympic boxing gold medalist Lin Yu-ting and 2025 Rhine-Ruhr World University Games swimming silver medalist Eddie Wang Kuan-hung to serve as National Sports Day

ambassadors. Together, they filmed a promotional video and announced two attractive special offers: free access to national sports facilities on September 9 and free fitness assessments across Taiwan throughout September. The public is warmly invited to join in and “Exercise on September 9, Stay Healthy for a Long Time!”

Taiwan’s first Olympic boxing gold medalist Lin joined hands with “Taiwan’s Butterfly King” Wang to film the National Sports Day promotional video, which will air on various TV channels from September. Collaborating for the first time, the two athletes expressed mutual admiration for each other’s outstanding performances in international competitions. On set, they brought the spirit of National Sports Day to life with vibrant energy and a playful, engaging style, while sharing information about the two nationwide special offers. The campaign aims to inspire everyone to exercise regularly and invites all to “move together on the 9th!”

For National Sports Day, the Department is promoting two special offers: 1. Free access to public sports

facilities – On September 9, National Sports Day, national sports centers and public sports facilities will be open free of charge to the public. 2. Free fitness assessments using technology – Throughout September, fitness assessments across Taiwan will be free. The Department has also arranged for mobile technology fitness assessment vehicles to tour Taiwan, with two vehicles operating simultaneously. These assessment activities will be held in four regions – North, Central, South, and East Taiwan—inviting the public to visit Taipei Syntrend Creative Park, Hsinchu Far Eastern Mega Mall, Kaohsiung Hanshin Arena Shopping Plaza, and Hualien Dongdamen Square to experience sports technology services.

Due to last year’s enthusiastic response, this year’s event specially invited the two ambassadors, Lin Yu-Ting and Eddie Wang, to attend the Taipei events on September 13 and 20 at Syntrend Creative Park to celebrate with the public. The goal is to connect people across Taiwan, promote physical health, and encourage regular exercise. These two free activities aim to invite the public to embrace “Exercise on

September 9, Stay Healthy for a Long Time” and further enhance the nation-wide sports for all atmosphere.

Taiwanese athletes have achieved remarkable results internationally this year, winning 5 gold, 13 silver, and 7 bronze medals at the Rhine-Ruhr World University Games, and 5 gold, 6 silver, and 4 bronze at the Chengdu World Games, showing Taiwan’s sporting power. After a year of preparation, research, and planning, incorporating suggestions from various sectors and being the subject of public expectations, the Ministry of Sports and the Department of Sports For All were officially established on September 9.

Together, they aim to promote sports for all, create a more complete and friendly sports environment in Taiwan, and establish a solid foundation for national health.

The Department stated that the “National Sports Act” designates September 9 as National Sports Day to convey to the public that everyone, regardless of age or occupation, should maintain regular exercise to stay physically and mentally healthy. 9月國民體育日活動起跑 兩大優惠邀請全民一起動

為強化及持續推廣全民運動，運動部全民運動署「國民體育日」系列活動於9月正式起跑，今(114)年特別邀請2024年巴黎奧運拳擊金牌選手林郁婷及2025年德國萊茵魯爾世界大學運動會游泳銀牌選手王冠閔，共同擔任114年度國民體育日代言人，合作拍攝宣傳影片，更加碼宣布兩大免費活動起跑，9月9日全國運動設施免費用、9月全臺體適能檢測免費做，邀請大家一起「運動99、健康久久」。

臺灣首位奧運拳擊金牌選手林郁婷，攜手「臺灣蝶王」王冠閔共同拍攝國民體育日宣傳影片，於9月起將在各電視臺播出，首度合作的兩人都非常肯定彼此在國際競賽場上的表現，也在拍攝現場滿滿活力的傳達國民體育日的核心精神，以趣味活潑的方式，將國民體育日兩大免費好康資訊融入影片中，期望全民力行規律運動，也邀請大家9要一起動！

全民運動署因應國民體育日推動兩大免費活動，「免費1：公共運動設施免費用」，9月9日國民體育日當天，國民運動中心與公立公共運動設施將免費開放供民衆使用；「免費2：科技體適能檢測免費做」，9月份全臺體適能檢測免費，體育署更規劃科技體適能檢測車巡迴全臺進行檢測活動，兩臺檢測車同時開跑，檢測活動將於北、中、南、

東四地辦理，邀請各地區民衆於活動日期，前往臺北三創生活園區、新竹遠東巨城購物中心、高雄漢神巨蛋購物廣場、花蓮東大門廣場，體驗運動科技服務。

由於去年響應熱烈，今年特別邀請兩位代言人 - 林郁婷與王冠閔，分別出席9月13日與9月20日臺北場三創生活園區與全民同樂，期望串聯全臺民衆一起，達到身體健康及規律運動目標，藉由兩免費活動能夠邀請全民一同響應「運動99、健康久久」並進而提升全民運動風氣。

我國運動選手於今年在國際體壇屢創佳績，萊茵魯爾世界大學運動會勇奪5金13銀7銅，在成都世界運動會更摘下5金6銀4銅的亮眼成績，展現臺灣運動實力。歷經一年的籌備、研議與規劃，融合各界建議並集結國人期待，運動部及全民運動署已於今年9月9日正式成立，攜手推動全民運動發展，為臺灣營造更完整、友善的運動環境，為全民健康打造更堅實的基礎。

Due to the impact of Super Typhoon Ragasa, an overflow occurred at the upstream barrier lake on the Mataian Stream, severely affecting downstream areas. Guangfu Township

in Hualien County suffered flooding, road closures, and bridge collapses. While providing disaster relief and support to the local community, the Ministry of Sports also noted that many

valuable sports cultural relics may have been lost or damaged. To preserve these precious memories of Taiwan’s glorious sports past, the Ministry has commissioned the Taiwan Splendid Sports Chronicles Project teams at National Kaohsiung Normal University, National University of Tainan, and National Taiwan University of Arts to actively assist with the rescue, cleaning, and short-term preservation of sports cultural relics. These emergency measures aim to minimize the damage and salvage these invaluable sports relics.

Guangfu Township in Hualien County has been the cradle of many of Taiwan’s competitive athletes, including: Athletics: Tian A-mei (1966 Asian Games silver medalist; 1968 Olympian); Wu A-min (1966 Asian Games gold medalist; 1964 and 1968 Olympian); Basketball: Chuang Rui-mei (part of the “Five Tigers of East Asia”); Women’s football: Lin Chiung-ying, Lin Man-ting, Tan Wen-lin, Wang Hsiang-hui (overseas players/national team captain/former women’s football union director); Boxing: Chen Nien-chin (2024 Olympic bronze medalist); Baseball: Chuang Chu-ming, Huang Chung-yi, Chou Si-chi, Kao Guo-hui, Wang Guang-hui, Chen Yi-hsin, among many others; all of these athletes have deep connections to this area.

As the department responsible for collecting, preserving, representing, exhibiting, and promoting Taiwan’s sports cultural heritage, the Ministry of Sports has long been committed to projects focused on the preservation, archiving, and promotion of sports culture. In light of the potential loss or damage to sports cultural assets caused by the recent disaster in Guangfu Township, Hualien County, the Ministry will take proactive steps to provide assistance.

運動部啟動花蓮縣光復鄉運動文物救援行動

強烈颱風樺加沙外圍環流影響，馬太鞍溪上游堰塞湖發生溢流，影響下游地區，導致花蓮縣光復鄉淹水、道路中斷及橋樑沖毀等重大災情。在為當地祈福、援助、救災的同時，運動部注意到許多珍貴的運動文物可能因此散佚或毀損，為保存珍貴體壇記憶，運動部委託高師大、臺南大學、臺藝大辦理之臺灣風華紀事計畫專案團隊，將主動協助運動文物之救援、清理、短期保存等應急事宜，儘可能地減緩災情帶來之傷害，搶救珍貴的運動文物。

花蓮縣光復鄉是我國諸多競技運動選手的搖籃，田徑的田阿妹(1966年亞運銀牌；1968年奧運選手)、吳阿民(1966年亞運金牌；1964年、1968年奧運選手)等；籃球的莊瑞美(亞東五虎)等；女足的林瓊鶯、林曼婷、譚汶琳、王湘惠(旅外球員／女足國家隊長女足／前女足工會理事長王湘惠)

等；拳擊的陳念琴(2024年奧運銅牌)；及眾多棒球好手，如莊初明、黃忠義、周思齊、高國輝、王光輝、陳義信等，均與此地有著極深的淵源。

運動部作為「運動文化記憶之蒐藏、保存、再現、展示及推廣」之單位，長期推動運動文化相關保存、典藏及推廣計畫，針對花蓮縣光復鄉災情可能造成之運動文化記憶散佚或毀損，將主動提供協助。運動部呼籲，如有運動文物之救援、清理、短期保存之需求，請儘速聯絡臺灣風華紀事計畫專案團隊(聯絡人：國立臺南大學蘇育瑤先生，辦公室電話：06-2130126，手機：0918586789，Email: suyuyao@mail.nutn.edu.tw)，團隊將適時提供必要的支援及協助，共同保存珍貴體壇記憶。

The Former Sports Administration Secures Budget from the Executive Yuan to Launch Planning for the Construction of the Taiwan Institute of Sports Science Building

The former Sports Administration (SA) of the Ministry of Education has secured NT\$1.96 billion in funding approved by the Executive Yuan for

the “Taiwan Institute of Sports Science New Building Construction Project,” aiming to enhance training facilities and research spaces, strengthen sports sci-

ence support, and comprehensively improve Taiwan's sports competitiveness. The goal is to complete construction in 2029 and commence operations in 2030.

Taiwanese athletes have delivered impressive performances in international sports competitions in recent years. As well as the tireless efforts of athletes and coaches and the support of various government policies, the integration and application of sports science have played a crucial role in athlete training and competition.

To support sports development, the government has continuously promoted the “National Sports Park

Development and Talent Cultivation Plan,” gradually improving the training facilities at the National Sports Training Center (NSTC). To further strengthen Taiwan's sports science capabilities, enhance international competitiveness, and acknowledge the importance and necessity of sports science development, the Executive Yuan approved the implementation of the Taiwan Institute of Sports Science (TISS) Establishment Act, effective August 1, 2023.

To help the TISS operate at maximum effectiveness and provide athletes and coaches with timely professional consultation and advice, a temporary measure has been to coordinate with the NSTC to use part of its existing facilities. To ensure the long-term operation of the TISS, the Sports Administration proposed the “Taiwan Institute of Sports Science New Building Construction Project” in 2024. The project includes various office spaces, laboratory spaces, testing areas, and research facilities for the TISS. The Executive Yuan approved the plan on March 21, 2025, marking a significant step forward in enhancing the sports science support environment.

The total budget for the “Taiwan Institute of Sports Science New Building Construction Project” is NT\$1.96 billion, with execution beginning in 2025. The architectural plan includes a six-story building with one basement level for the TISS, an integrated semi-outdoor virtual-physical training experimental field, and a sports science measurement field. The building will have office spaces, professional testing, analysis, and laboratory facilities related to sports science, as well as research center spaces to support athlete training and experimental analysis development.

The project site is located on the former Military Academy campus land on the east side of the NSTC. The former SA has been coordinating with the Ministry of National Defense for land allocation. The overall construction project has been entrusted to the Na-

tional Land Management Administration (NLMA) of the Ministry of the Interior, which also manages the NSTC’s multi-use training hall, swimming pool, and tennis courts. With their expertise and familiarity, the construction of the Taiwan Institute of Sports Science building is expected to advance smoothly. The overall project plans to solicit architectural bids in the third quarter of 2025, with a target completion date in 2029 and operational commencement in 2030.

The former SA stated that it will continue to closely cooperate with the NLMA, TISS, and the NSTC to accelerate project implementation, aiming to complete the Taiwan Institute of Sports Science building as soon as possible so that TISS can function to maximum effect and help athletes achieve the best results.

■ 體育署向行政院爭取預算 啟動運科中心大樓籌建規劃

教育部體育署爭取行政院核定 19.6 億元經費，推動「國家運動科學中心大樓新建計畫」，完善培訓設施與研究空間，強化運科支援，全面提升我國運動競爭力，目標 118 年完成，119 年運營。

近幾年我國運動選手於國際運動賽會競技成績表現亮眼，除選手、教練持續不懈的努力及政府各項政策支持外，運動科學支援與導入在選手培訓與參賽上扮演重要關鍵角色。

政府為支持體育發展，除持續推動「國家運動園區整體興設與人才培育計畫」，逐步完善國家運動訓練中心(下稱國訓中心)各項培訓設施外，為強化我國運動科學軟實力，提升國際運動競爭力，並考量發展運動科學的重要性及必要性，行政院核定自 112 年 8 月 1 日施行國家運動科學中心(下稱運科中心)設置條例。

為協助運科中心運作發揮最大效能，提供選手、教練所需即時的專業諮詢與建議，目前權宜方式係協調國訓中心以其既有場館之部分空間提供使用，為利運科中心長遠運作，體育署於 113 年提出「國家運動科學中心大樓新建計畫」，包含運科中心各類辦公空間、實驗空間、檢測空間、研究空間等，並經行政院於 114 年 3 月 21 日核定，為運科支援環境推動邁出一大步。

「國家運動科學中心大樓新建計畫」計畫總經費為 19.6 億元，於 114 年起執行，建築量體初步規劃為地下 1 樓地上 6 樓之運科大樓 1 棟、半戶外虛實整合訓練實驗場及運動科學測量場 1 座，其中運科大樓部分，除辦公空間外，設有運科相關專業檢測、分析、實驗室等及研究中心空間，提供運科導入支援分析選手培訓及實驗分析發展。

基地開發用地位於國訓中心東側之國防部士校營區土地，體育署已逐步協調國防部撥用，另整體工程委託內政部國土管理署全程專業代辦，該署也是國訓中心綜合集訓館、游泳館及網球場的代辦機關，相信在專業度及合作熟悉度上，能使運科中心大樓新建推動更進一步。整體工程預計 114 年第 3 季辦理建築師招標遴選，目標於 118 年完成，於 119 年啟動運營。

體育署表示，將持續與內政部國土管理署、運科中心及國訓中心密切合作，加速計畫相關作業執行，期儘早完成運科大樓籌建，讓運科中心能發揮更大的功能，幫助選手全力爭取佳績。

Taiwan Accessible Ocean Day Held as Minister Lee Yang Highlights Sports Equality

To support the national “Accessible Ocean” policy, Minister of Sports Lee Yang attended the “Taiwan Accessible Ocean Day” event on September 27, 2025, jointly initiated by the Ming-Yi Foundation and the Wheelchair Dream Park Alliance. Together with Vice President Hsiao Bi-khim, Minister

Kuan Bi-ling of the Ocean Affairs Council, and 200 wheelchair users, Minister Lee took part in a joint pledge at Fulong Beach, pledging that the ocean is part of the DNA of all Taiwanese people, and sports are a basic right for every citizen.

To support “Taiwan Accessible Ocean Day,” Minister Lee personally entered the sea to participate in an accessible kayaking experience. He stated that adaptive sports are a core responsibility of the Ministry of Sports. This firsthand experience, seeing the smiles of the participants, strengthened his determination to promote adaptive sports policies. As an island nation, Taiwan’s coasts and oceans are among the most beloved environments for sports and leisure. Going forward, the Ministry will assess various water sports facilities nationwide, aiming to make them widely accessible so that citizens with physical and mental disabilities can participate locally.

This event also attracted international participants from Japan, South Korea, Malaysia, Oman, Indonesia, Thailand, and France, demonstrating not only the implementation of sports equality policies but also serving as a highly successful example of sports diplomacy.

Vice President Hsiao Bi-khim said in her speech that Taiwan has always actively participated in the international

community. She said “Taiwan Accessible Ocean Day” showcases equality and shared growth to the world: “Everyone is taken care of and can enjoy the beauty of nature. The true strength of a society does not lie in how far one person can go, but in ensuring that no one is left behind as we move forward together.”

Minister Kuan of the Ocean Affairs Council expressed gratitude to Vice President Hsiao and Minister Lee for attending and hoped that with government policy support and collective efforts, an accessible marine industry

chain can be developed: “Explore the ocean and make it a part of the lives of Taiwanese people.”

The Ministry of Sports stated that Taiwan has over 1.23 million people with physical and mental disabilities, plus more than 2 million citizens with hidden or temporary disabilities who require services. The government aims to create an adaptive sports environ-

ment that is characterized by “lifelong participation, profession support and institutional innovation,” integrating resources across agencies to promote multiple new programs. Like a sports team, in the spirit of Team Taiwan, this will establish a sustainable foundation for adaptive sports development, supporting Taiwan together and promoting sports equality for people with disabilities.

臺灣無障礙海洋日登場 李洋部長親自體驗推廣運動平權

為支持響應國家「海洋無障礙」政策，運動部李洋部長 114 年 9 月 27 日出席由明怡基金會與輪椅夢公園聯盟共同發起的「臺灣無障礙海洋日」活動，與總統府蕭美琴副總統、海洋委員會管碧玲主委及 200 名輪椅使用者在福隆海水浴場共同宣誓，海洋是全體臺灣人民的 DNA，運動是每一位國民的基本權益。

李洋部長為支持「臺灣無障礙海洋日」，親自入海參與無障礙獨木舟體驗，部長受訪時表示，適應運動是運動部的核心業務，透過今日親自體驗，看到參與者

的笑容，更加堅定推動適應運動政策的決心，臺灣是海島國家，海岸、海洋是國人最喜愛的運動休閒環境之一，展望未來，運動部將盤點各項親水運動設施，期待普及全國，方便身心障礙國民就近參與。而本次活動吸引日本、韓國、馬來西亞、阿曼、印尼、泰國、法國等國際友人到場，可說落實運動平權政策外，更是做了最成功的運動外交示範。

蕭美琴副總統致詞指出，臺灣一直積極參與國際社會，從今天的「臺灣無障礙海洋日」正是向世界展示平權、共榮的成長，「每

個人都被照顧到，共享大自然的美好，一個社會真正的力量不在於一個人能夠走多遠，而是在於必須確保一起向前走的時候沒有人被遺落。」；海洋委員會管碧玲主委則表示，感謝蕭美琴副總統及李洋部長欣然應允出席，期待在政府政策支持及大家攜手努力下，能夠發展海洋無障礙的產業鏈，「探索海洋，讓海洋成為臺灣人民生活的一部分。」

運動部表示，臺灣身心障礙人口逾 123 萬人，且另有超過 200 萬隱性或短期失能的國民有被服務需求，政府將努力打造「終身參與、專業支持、制度創新」的適應運動環境，並將整合跨部會資源，推動多項新興計畫，就像運動團隊一樣，以 Team Taiwan 的精神，建立適應運動永續發展制度基礎，讓我們一起挺臺灣、挺身障礙運動平權。

Taiwan's Women's Recurve Archery Team Triumphs with the First World Championship Gold Since the Ministry of Sport's Establishment

On September 10, Taiwan athletes Chiu Yi-ching, Hsu Hsin-tse, and Lee Tsai-hsuan participated in the 2025 World Archery Championships in Gwangju, South Korea. In the women's recurve team event, they delivered

precise performances and, with steady skill, defeated Japan in the gold medal match. This marks the first-ever gold medal in an individual sport World Championship for Taiwan's national team since the establishment of the

Ministry of Sports, making it a highly significant achievement. President William Lai learned of the good news immediately and promptly sent a congratulatory message, praising the outstanding performance of the three athletes and the coaching team and recognizing their steadfast spirit in winning glory for Taiwan.

All members of this women's team are athletes in the "Golden Plan" or the training squad for next year's Asian Games. After long-term training, they showed the results of their daily hard work on the highest-level competitive stage. In the final, under their coach's guidance, they demonstrated excellent team coordination and defeated the strong Japanese team with a commanding 6–0 score (53–51, 53–52, 54–44), winning the gold medal and honor and applause for Taiwan.

The Ministry of Sports stated that archery has long been a key focus of Taiwan's competitive sports development. This remarkable achievement coincides with the Ministry's official inauguration on September 9, 2025,

making it a double celebration. The Ministry reaffirmed its commitment to investing in comprehensive training and support for athletes, while advancing six major goals: promoting sports for all, strengthening competitive systems, enhancing Taiwan's visibility in hosting major international events, fostering the sports industry, promoting sustainability and diversity, and cultivating youth and grassroots talent. These efforts aim to create a better sports environment, and allow Taiwan's athletes to shine on the world stage and continue winning glory.

我國邱意晴、許芯慈、李采璇選手於 9 月 10 日在韓國光州參加 2025 年世界射箭錦標賽，於反曲弓女子團體項目，以精準的表現，在金牌戰以穩健的技術擊敗日本，榮獲金牌。此為我國代表隊在運動部成立後的第一面單項運動世界錦標賽金牌，意義非凡。賴清德總統於第一時間獲悉捷報，旋即拍發賀電，祝賀 3 位選手與教練團的優異表現，肯定她們以堅毅精神為國爭光。

我國女子團體本次代表隊成員皆為「黃金計畫」或明年亞洲運動會培訓隊選手，經歷長期培訓，在最高層級競技舞臺展現平日苦練的成果，決賽在教練指導下展現團隊默契，以 6 比 0 (53 比 51、53 比 52、54 比 44) 絕對優勢擊敗強敵日本，成功摘金，為我國贏得榮耀與掌聲。

運動部表示，射箭向來是我國競技運動的重點發展項目，此次佳績正好與 114 年 9 月 9 日運動部揭牌相呼應，堪稱雙喜臨門。運動部強調，未來將持續挹注資源，提供選手完善的訓練及後勤支援，並積極落實全民運動、整合競技運動結構與制度、提升臺灣舉辦國際大型賽會的能力與能見度、促進運動產業的商業發展、實踐永續與多元價值、投入青少年與基層人才培育等六大方向，期盼完善我國運動環境，並讓更多運動員能在世界舞台展現實力，再接再厲，為我國續創佳績，寫下榮耀新篇章。
